Health Savings Accounts (HSAs)

How it works

A Health Savings Account (HSA) is a tax-advantaged savings account that lets you save on taxes when you pay for medical and other health-related expenses, both current and future, if you have a high-deductible health plan (HDHP).



Account holders 55+ can deposit an additional \$1,000 in catch-up contributions per year.

The IRS provides a comprehensive list of qualified medical expenses. Here are some other examples of what can be paid from your HSA:

- Dental and Vision care: dental treatments, vision exams, eyeglasses, and contact lenses
- Medical Equipment: items like wheelchairs, crutches, and hearing aids
- Family Planning: contraceptives, prenatal care, and postpartum care

HSA funds are for medical expenses, and using them for non-medical purposes can result in penalties and taxes.
